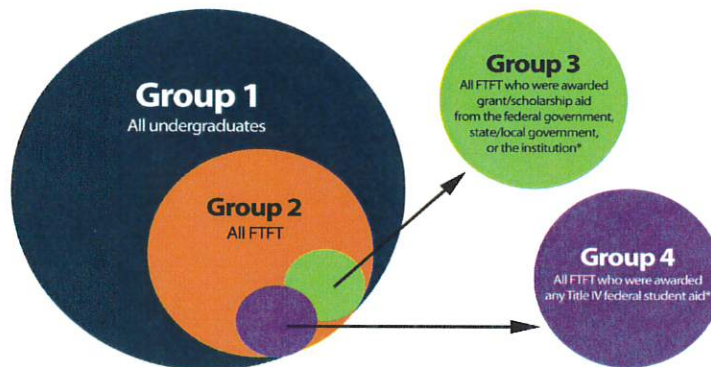
Overview
